Space Aliens at Liberty



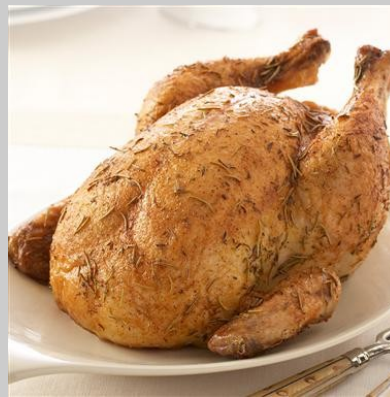

School lunch has been coming back to haunt students, and we're not just talking about the healthy choices. It turns out the meat may have been made from zombie creatures.



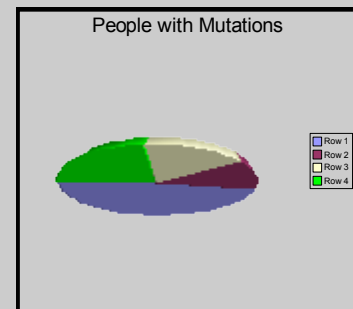
Watch for movements at lunch
