Tables begin with a tag that's easy to remember. The tag is simply . Be extra careful to **ALWAYS** finish the tag with or your whole page will be a mess. When you have a table, you can't put anything along side of the table (yet) but can only have items above and below it.

ROWSPAN and COLSPAN

If you make this, you'll notice a problem with the top row. The single cell only goes half way across.
