## **Shape Tweens: Square and Circle** (10 points)

Using a "shape tween" you need to turn a blue square into a red figure-eight shape (colors negotiable).

## Basics:

- 1. Create a blue square with a stroke (line) on the outside of it.
- 2. Create a keyframe further down the timeline (about 35 frames or so).
- 3. Add a red circle with a stroke on the second keyframe.
- 4. Right-click on the timeline and add a shape tween.
- 5. Delete the blue square from the second keyframe.
- 6. Copy the circle and overlap it with the first.
- 7. Delete the overlapping stroke.
- 8. On a separate layer, add your name.
- 9. Safe the .fla file, but export the MOVIE as a .swf, specifically shapeTweenFirstLast.png Sally Smith would save it as shapeTweenSallySmith.png
- 10. Mail the .swf to me.
