Video: Mood in a Minute

One thing that can be conveyed by a video is emotion. The same video clip can be used to convey different emotions depending on the timing, effects, filters, and music. For this lesson, choose a mood and create a video using clips that will convey that mood. The video must be **EXACTLY ONE MINUTE LONG**.

- Step 1: Choose a mood you want to convey. Fear, love, happiness, sadness, confusion, craziness, hope, innocence, anger, or the mood of your choice may work. Find video clips that will help convey the mood, and effects that will add to it. Once you have assembled your pieces, put your video together.
- Step 2: This sounds weird, but do not put your title until the end of the video. At the first, put the credits. This should include your name, the name of the song, and the site where you found the clips. You can choose whether or not to have your music playing at this time.
- Step 3: Put your video together using transitions, effects, and the clips. Make it rock. You can include some stills, but your main video should be video.
- Step 4: At the end of your video, you need your title page. This should be the mood you were working to present.
- Step 5: Email your video

NOTE: Your video should be **EXACTLY 1 minute**. Time limit is strict.
