Sound: Ring Tone

A ring tone is a very short bit of music. It is made to play over and over. Most ring tones are less than the length of a song, and are made to capture attention.

You need to create a ring tone. You may use any song you'd like, provided that it may be playable in school. No profanity, explicit lyrics, or anything degrading is allowed. Your ring tone must be edited down to under 30 seconds.

You need to add an effect, such as fade out, change tempo, or another effect. Your choice.

Here's what you need to do

1. Choose a song. You may provide one of your own, or use one provided for you. If you're out of ideas, try one of these two:

- 2. Load it into Audacity, and find the section you want repeated as a ring tone
- 3. Cut the remaining sounds off of the song.
- 4. Add an effect into at least part of the song. You can choose any effect.
- 5. EXPORT the song. You must save it as an MP3 file. WARNING .aup (Audacity files) cannot be graded. You must export the song to get credit.
